The mission staff lead and support Team Nova Scotia, liaise with the host society, and work prior to, during and after the Games to ensure that our athletes, coaches, and managers can concentrate on their competitions and performances while at the Games.

Team Mi'kmaw Nova Scotia is seeking ambitious, organized, and committed individuals to serve as Mission Staff for the 2020 North American Indigenous Games.

Mission staff will report to the Chef de Mission and work closely with the Assistant Chef de Mission and their assigned sport(s), acting as support staff and a sport liaison. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: building strong relationships with manager and coaches of assigned sport(s), completing duties prior to the Games in collaboration with the manager of assigned sport(s), ensuring vital communication is received by assigned sport(s), and assisting assigned sport(s) throughout the Games where necessary.

The ideal candidate must display professionalism, an eagerness to serve, and acute ability to problem solve. The ideal candidate is a strong administrator and communicator, a self-motivator and team player, and has a comprehensive knowledge of both the Indigenous and mainstream sport system in Nova Scotia.

Mission Staff must be available for the duration of the Games, July 11 - July 19, 2020.

All are encouraged to apply, however, individuals with Indigenous ancestry will be considered an asset.
